Ideal for anyone wanting to try their hand at a Sportive for the first time or just wanting to enjoy a ride around the beautiful Cornish countryside. Be warned! It does have a real Sportive challenge for you at Poldhu Cove.

Heading South from our site you pass through the pretty waterside village of Gweek before reaching the Southern tip of RNAS Cuddeon and on to Goonhilly Earth Station. Goonhilly is an area of outstanding natural beauty and received the very first live TV pictures from the USA via the Telstar Satellite.

Continuing South passed Cadgwith Cove, then turning up towards Mullion Village and the lovely Poldhu Cove. Turning North, a welcome sight awaits at RNAS Cuddeon for the first Water/Snack Station. This is your feed station where water, a sandwich and sugar sweets await you, to help you with your journey home.

The route now parts company with the other 2 and starts Heading back via Gweek once more passing through narrow lanes for which Cornwall is well known.
